Burton Green Neighbourhood Plan Area

Referendum on the Burton Green Neighbourhood Plan

1. A referendum will be held on Thursday 24 March 2022 to decide on the question below:

“Do you want Warwick District Council to use the Neighbourhood Plan for Burton Green to help it decide planning applications in the neighbourhood area?”

2. Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 12 midnight on Tuesday, 8 March 2022. Applications can be made online: <https://www.gov.uk/register-to-vote>.
3. Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes and amendments or cancellations of proxy votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Warwick District Council, Riverside House, Milverton Hill, Royal Leamington Spa, Warwickshire, CV32 5HZ by 5 pm on Wednesday, 9 March 2022. Applications can be emailed to elections@warwickdc.gov.uk.
4. New applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Warwick District Council, Riverside House, Milverton Hill, Royal Leamington Spa, Warwickshire, CV32 5HZ by 5 pm on Wednesday, 16 March 2022. Applications can be emailed to elections@warwickdc.gov.uk.
5. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this referendum on grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Warwick District Council, Riverside House, Milverton Hill, Royal Leamington Spa, Warwickshire, CV32 5HZ by 5 pm on Thursday, 24 March 2022. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5 pm on Wednesday, 16 March 2022. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5 pm on Wednesday, 16 March 2022. Applications can be emailed to elections@warwickdc.gov.uk.
